Information obligation clause – participant of scientific events at the Greater Poland Cancer Centre

pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as the GDPR, please be informed that:

1. 3. Your personal data is processed on the basis of:
 - a) Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR (expressed consent) for the purposes of registering for events and contacting participants and passing on selected materials after the event and receiving future information on the dates and topics of future scientific events of the Greater Poland Cancer Centre at the e-mail address provided,
 - b) Article 6(1)(b) GDPR (performance or conclusion of an agreement) in connection with the performance of activities related to participation in a scientific event organised by the Greater Poland Cancer Centre.
 - c) Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR (legal obligation of the Administrator) for tax and accounting purposes in connection with the billing of the user's participation in the scientific event
4. If the Greater Poland Cancer Centre collects personal data directly from you, please be informed that your provision of data is a prerequisite for your participation in the scientific event referred to in point. 3 of this clause.
5. You have the right of access to the content of your data, the right to rectification, the right to object, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability to another administrator, or, if the processing is based on consent, the right to withdraw it at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
